

**FAMILY PET CLINIC BOARDING POLICY**

Welcome to Family Pet Clinic. Thank you for choosing us as your Boarding Facility. All clients are required to read and sign the following boarding admitting form.

At Family Pet Clinic we require all dogs to be current of the rabies (\$22.00) vaccine, the da2pp (distemper/parvo) (\$33.00) vaccine, the semi-annual bordetella(\$30.00) vaccine, the influenza(\$27.00) vaccine, and a negative fecal(\$25.00) within the last year. All cats are required to be current of the rabies (\$29.50) vaccine, FVRCP(feline distemper/upper respiratory) (\$33.00) vaccine and a negative fecal(\$25.00) within the last year. If proof of required vaccinations and a negative fecal are not provided upon check in, then vaccinations will be automatically given to protect your pet(s) and other pet(s) within the clinic. If the pet has a positive fecal, appropriate dewormer will be given at the owner’s expense. The cost of all required procedures for boarding will be the responsibility of the owner.

On the day of pick up, any pet picked up before 8:30am will not be charged an additional day. Any pet picked up after 8:30am will be charged an additional day.

## FAMILY PET CLINIC BOARDING POLICY

- If your pet(s) tests POSITIVE for any intestinal parasites, your pet(s) will be treated at your expense. The cost of most dewormers, **depending on type of parasite and medication used**, will range between \$8.95 and \$45.85.
- All dogs **must have** current immunizations against Annual Rabies (\$22), Annual DHLPPC (\$33), Semi-Annual Bordetella (\$30), Annual Influenza (\$27) and an Annual Negative Fecal (\$25.00). If the patient is a puppy, the patient must be vaccinated appropriately for its age.
- Boarding is charged per pet(s)/per day(s). Charges are as follows: Small (Under 19.5#) \$15.00/day, Medium (20-39.5#) \$18.00/day, Large (40-74.5#) \$21.25/day, and X-Large (75# & Up) \$26.00/day.
- All cats **must have** current immunizations against Annual Rabies (\$29.50), Annual FVRCP (\$33), and have an Annual Negative Fecal (\$25.00). If the patient is a kitten, the patient must be vaccinated appropriately for its age.
- Boarding is charged per pet(s)/per day(s). Charges for cat boarding per day is \$16.00/day. If you are boarding an INTACTED MALE, the price of boarding per day will be \$27.50.
- All pets must be free of external parasites (fleas, ticks, ear mites, mange, etc) when admitted for boarding; or must be treated upon admission. There **will be** an additional charge to the owner for external parasite treatment. The medication given for treatments of fleas is called a CAPSTAR at a cost of \$13. If an additional topical medication needs to be applied due to severe infestation of fleas or ticks, a FRONTLINE **will be** applied. A frontline single dose ranges between \$21.95 and \$26.95 depending on the size of your pet. For cats, a REVOLUTION **will be** applied at the cost of \$21.99 per dose per cat. If your pet(s) is a suspect for skin or ear mites, ringworm, or other infectious disease of the skin, the appropriate diagnostics, such as skin scrapings or ear cytology may be required in order to rule out infectious parasites that could jeopardize the health or safety of other pets.
- A bath or groom is optional **on the day of dismissal**, however are charged separate from the boarding fees. Normal boarding charges will still apply if you request a bath or a groom. If a bath or groom is requested, the price will depend on the size of the animal or type of groom requested and will be performed the morning of the anticipated discharge date. Your pet **will be released between 5:00 and 6:00 p.m.** unless a phone call is made to inform you that your pet(s) is ready to go home sooner. **NO BATHS/GROOMS WILL BE PERFORMED ON WEEKENDS OR DURING NON-BUSINESS HOURS** for the safety of your pet and our staff. You will be charged an additional day of boarding if you choose to have pet bathed or groomed on the day of pick up. We do offer bathing and grooming the day prior to pick up, just keep in mind that your pet may not be fresh upon pick up.
- Pets will be admitted & discharged **ONLY** during regular office hours. **After hours discharges will not be permitted.**
- We furnish all normal food, bedding, three daily bathroom breaks Monday through Saturday, and twice daily bathroom breaks on Sunday. We do not have overnight supervision. We do have closed circuit video surveillance, smoke detectors, and a security alarm system. We inspect our facilities daily to check for safety hazards.
- Any animal that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it at our discretion and at the owner's expense. We will attempt to contact you before non life-saving medical treatment is instituted at the emergency contact number provided, but if you can not be reached in a reasonable amount of time, life saving and medically necessary treatment will be performed as needed at your expense. Be aware that your pet's diet may have varied while boarding away from home. Since their foods and environments are different, this can create problems such as upset stomach, sore throats, tonsillitis, respiratory infections, or diarrhea. We seek to prevent such problems, but you must understand that these problems do develop as pets are in an unfamiliar environment and may be more stressed than usual. We make every effort to make your pet(s) feel as comfortable as possible. Pets requiring medication or treatment will be charged appropriate fees at the owner's expense.
- Pets may be unpredictable, especially in an unfamiliar environment. Please understand that there are inherent risks in working with and caring for pets. Accidents or injuries may occur. Pets are walked on a leash separately from other pet(s). We do not allow direct contact between pets. Pets are always boarded in separate kennels and walked separately unless specifically requested to be boarded or walked together by the owner or authorized agent. In the event that pet(s) are requested to be boarded or walked together, they will be separated at the sole discretion of Family Pet Clinic, if a pet's safety or well being is compromised. If it is requested that pet(s) be boarded or walked together, and any injury occurs to your pet(s), it will be treated at the owner's expense and you will not hold Family Pet Clinic liable for any damages, injuries, including but not limited to death, that may occur to your pet(s) as a result of your request to have the pet(s) boarded or walked together.

## FAMILY PET CLINIC BOARDING POLICY

- Family Pet Clinic does our very best to take all reasonable precautions while handling and caring for your pet(s). In the event that an accident involving your pet(s) does occur, not limited to but including escape or death of your pet(s), you agreed not to hold Family Pet Clinic, any of the employed staff, owners, or veterinarian liable for damages.
  
- If I, the undersigned and owner or authorized agent of the owner, have requested that medical, surgical, dental, or other services be performed for my pet(s) while residing in the boarding kennel, I consent to and authorize the Family Pet Clinic to perform diagnostic, therapeutic, anesthetic, emergency, and surgical procedures as are necessary and advisable for the treatment and maintenance of my pet's health and well-being. I understand that with any procedure or treatment that there are risks that may not be predictable, including death, and I accept these risks. While I expect all procedures to be performed to the best of the abilities of the staff, I acknowledge that no guarantee or warranty regarding the outcome or results of any treatment has been given. I acknowledge that hair may be shaved or clipped as necessary to facilitate treatment. I expect that reasonable precautions will be used to ensure my pet's safety and well-being while in Family Pet Clinic's care, and I agree to pay in full for all services provided at the time of discharge. I understand that if an unanticipated need for additional procedures or services (e.g. extractions of teeth, biopsies of abnormal tissues, illness etc.) occurs, a reasonable effort will be made to contact me using the contact information provided above. I understand that if I cannot be contacted, that non-emergency procedures or services will not be performed, at that this may mean that my pet(s) may need to have another procedure at a future date at my expense.
  
- The undersigned hereby warrants that they are the owner or authorized agent for the pet(s) listed in this record and does consent and authorize Family Pet Clinic to care for and treat said pet(s). If an emergency situation arises, I authorize services, including the use of anesthesia if necessary, to treat my pet(s) until such time as I can be contacted. I understand that every reasonable effort will be made to contact me as soon as possible if an emergency or unanticipated situation arises with my pet(s). If I am unable to be reached, I authorize the veterinarian(s) to proceed with treatment as deemed necessary for the well being of my pet(s). I understand I will be responsible for all charges incurred at checkout. I have read and understand **ALL 3 PAGES** of this document. This is a binding agreement upon signature for all present and future boarding for all pet(s) listed on your account unless written notification is given.
